

Town of Maple Creek Wastewater Treatment Grant Announced

Her Worship the Mayor of Maple Creek Ms. Michelle McKenzie, and Councillors Ellaine Hawrylak & Cara Teichroeb, were among those assembled at the Saskatchewan Legislative Building in Regina today for the announcement by the Honourable Ralph Goodale, Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness, on behalf of the Honourable François-Philippe Champagne, Minister of Infrastructure and Communities, and the Honourable Warren Kaeding, Minister of Government Relations, that the Town of Maple Creek was one of eight Saskatchewan communities to have been approved for infrastructure funding under the “New Building Canada Fund’s Provincial-Territorial Infrastructure Component – National & Regional Projects” program.

Through this program the Town of Maple Creek will receive \$3,960,000.00 from the governments of Canada & Saskatchewan for critical wastewater treatment upgrades at the Town of Maple Creek lagoon.
